Approval/Rejection	After the application deadline the student will be informed if he/she has been accepted.
Arrival day	Students are expected to arrive for the Welcome Events a week before the beginning of the semester.
Language of instruction	All our courses are offered in Italian only, but LABA Firenze provides language courses for foreign students.
Choice of Subjects	The student will be able to choose the subjects to attend courses for.
Portfolio	A portfolio is the only documentation required to be attached to the application.

## LIVING IN FLORENCE

### Approximate Monthly Costs (Euro) for:

- Accommodation (shared): 400€ - 700€
- Living costs: 300€ - 450€
- Public Transport: 30€ - 50€

### Housing

*\*Note: Finding accommodation in Florence can be a difficult and long process, we recommend to all the students to start looking in advance and be patient.*

LABA Firenze does not have an official accommodation for the students.

If you need more tips or suggestions do not hesitate to contact us and request our accommodation guide, but it is the responsibility of the student to secure suitable accommodation.

### Insurance

All EU/EEA students are required to obtain the **European Health Insurance Card** from their home country and to carry it with them at all times. Please note that this card only covers emergency treatment, so all students are advised to take out additional insurance before they travel.

### Visa information

It will not be necessary for you to obtain a residence permit in Italy beforehand if:

- You are a citizen of the EU/EEA (plus Iceland, Liechtenstein and Norway) or Switzerland. If you want to live in Italy, you will need to apply for a certificate from the register of European Union citizens.
- You are the spouse of a citizen of the EU/EEA or Switzerland, even if you are not a citizen of one of those countries, and you are with or join that person in Italy. If you want to live here, you will have to apply for an EU family residence card.
